Children should be collected from inside the school hall.









SCHOOL CONCERTS

As you know this year we are holding 3 Christmas Concerts:

P1 - P3 and P6 & P7 - notes from teachers.

Wednesday 13 December -

Children will go home after the morning concert with their parent or be picked up at 12 noon. J & K Coaches will collect the children at 11.45 am but Ulsterbus will be unable to accommodate us. The children should return to school between 6.15 pm and 6.30pm (wearing clothing as agreed with teacher - see separate note) for the evening concert which will start at 6.45 pm sharp.

Thursday 14 December -

School doors will open at 9.45 am for a 10.00 am school start. The PHOTOGRAPHER will be in school to take the children's photos in their costumes. Children should bring in the clothes needed for the concert performance to dress up for the photographer. These clothes will then be sent home for children to wear into school on Thursday evening for the concert.

J&K Coach will accommodate us on this day and pick-up will be <u>approx 1 hour later</u> than usual. There <u>will be a normal school closing of 2 pm or 3 pm</u>. Children should all return to school between **6.15 pm - 6.30 pm** for the final show **starting at 6.45pm** sharp.

Friday 15 December -

School doors will open at **9.45 am for a 10 am start**. J & K coaches will accommodate us on this day and pick up will be <u>approx. 1 hour later than usual</u>. <u>There will be a normal school closing of 2 pm or 3 pm</u>. This will be a non-uniform day – children may wear their Christmas jumper/top to the Christmas Dinner.


SCHOOL POLICY ON PHOTOS TAKEN BY PARENTS AT WHOLE SCHOOL EVENTS
