P5 SWIMMING COMMENCING FRIDAY 7 SEPTEMBER

Our P5 class will attend swimming lessons on a Friday for Term 1 (12 weeks) commencing 7 September until 30 November. P6 and P7 will attend during Term 2 and 3. There will be a charge of £2.50 per child for transport costs to the swimming pool for Term 1. The school will pay for each child's swimming lessons. This first payment of £30 must be received by Friday 14 September at the latest.

SCHOOL UNIFORM

The children are looking really well in their uniform and we want to remind everyone that black footwear should be worn daily. Thank you for your support in maintaining our high standards in behaviour and attitude to school.

We have some 'like new' uniform items available for anyone wanting a spare change for their child - £1 donation per item to School Funds.

PE UNIFORM – This should be sent to school in a named bag ASAP.

- Sky blue round neck t-shirt with motif (available at RA Cuddy)
- Navy shorts
- Navy joggers for cooler weather
- Black plimsols for indoor PE lessons. Trainers will only be needed for certain outdoor activities and you will be notified when they are required.

We would remind all parents to name each item of PE Kits, uniform and coats to avoid confusion and help to prevent loss.

EARLY BIRD CLUB 8.15 AM - 8.45AM

This club continues to be popular and costs 50p a day for any child wishing to attend. Online Childcare Vouchers may be used as payment for the club.

PAYMENT VOUCHERS

We would appreciate it if any parents paying After School/123/Early Bird clubs by voucher would itemize these clubs and name the child on their payment.

SAFETY AT OPENING AND HOME TIMES

We ask all parents to collect their child inside the school gates and walk them safely to their car each day. This is for your child's safety.



TEACHER DIFFICULTIES WITH CHANGE

Getting correct change for children to take home or send to other classes is always a problem for teachers and valuable class time is being used trying to balance class registers. Therefore, it would be appreciated if you could adhere to the following as far as possible:

- It is essential, if at all possible, that the correct money should be sent to <u>each</u> child's own class teacher.
- Dinner money is payable each Monday for the number of meals you wish your child to have that week. (This money is lodged each Monday afternoon.)
- We would encourage the use of personal cheques (made out to 'Education Authority, Southern Region') in payment for dinner and snack money. These can be included on one cheque but we would ask that each child has their own cheque/cash payment to be presented to their classroom teacher. The use of cheques and payment of monies on a monthly basis has proved to be very successful. If you wish to pay for the whole month please send in a note to your child's teacher detailing which days dinner is to be taken. This will only work if you are paying for the month in advance. NO CREDIT CAN BE GIVEN AS THE SCHOOL MUST PAY FOR THE DINNERS ON A WEEKLY BASIS.
- If however, due to unforeseen circumstances, money is brought in during the week please ensure that the <u>correct</u> amount is sent as it is very difficult for us to provide change after the Monday lodgment.
- All money should be in an envelope with the child's name and money details on the outside. Envelopes are available from the school office at a cost of £2.00 for 40 envelopes.

LOST PROPERTY



We have a number of hoodies, coats, hats, PE shorts, plimsols and other pieces of uniform in our lost property box. If your child has lost a coat or item of uniform please call in and check our box.

If not collected by September all these items will be recycled in our clothing bank.

P4 – P7 AFTER SCHOOL CLUBS

See Attached Timetable.

Please return the attached reply slip to school on Monday 3 September with payment to secure a place. Some clubs are limited to 24 spaces. Places will not be reserved for your child unless payment has been made for the club. Payment can be made by sending in the correct cash, a cheque (made payable to 'Woods Primary School') or using childcare vouchers online. If you are starting to use childcare vouchers for the first time you must speak to the Principal first. Always state on the child's form which method of payment you have used.

We are fortunate to have such a good variety of clubs running but unfortunately this is not provided by the Department of Education and is an extra school cost. With budgets being reduced we will only be able to continue with clubs that are popular and can cover their costs.

RETURN TO SCHOOL AFTER ABSENCE

If returning to school after an absence a parent <u>must send in a signed note</u> giving the reason why his/her child was absent.

SEPTEMBER HOME TIMES

We encourage our children to be as independent as possible and would like them to walk to their classroom by themselves, as soon as possible – certainly by Half term at the latest. There will always be a member of staff at the front door from 8.45 am to 9.00 am, when the bell rings for classes to commence, to ensure your child's safety. If your child arrives after 9.00 am they should be **brought into school** and signed in at the school office.

Parents of P1 children please remember that your child will be staying in school until 12.15pm until Friday 14 September. During the week 17 - 21 September P1 will stay in school for lunch and go home at 1.30 pm and from Monday 24 September 2018 P1 children will go home at 2pm. If any travel arrangements have changed since filling out the data form please let Mrs Gardiner know.

Please note: If your child is paying for Healthy Snack it is not necessary for them to bring any additional snack.

CHILD PROTECTION UP-DATE

PLEASE NOTE: <u>To comply with our up-dated Safeguarding school policy no child should bring a mobile phone/electronic toys into school.</u>

However, if you feel there is an occasion that it is necessary for your child to bring a phone into school it MUST be given to the class teacher and collected at the end of the school day.

We would also remind all parents to make sure that their children do not bring toys or special belongings to school as we do not want items to go missing or get broken. Playground toys and equipment are provided for playtime. Thank you for your co-operation.
