BIRTHDAY PARTY INVITES

In the past we have been made aware of the upset caused by children feeling 'left out' when party invitations are distributed in class and all of one gender are not invited. This upset hinders children's ability to focus on their learning and puts teachers in a difficult position. Our priority is children's happiness, contentment at school and their progress in learning. Please be aware of our school policy as follows:

PARTY INVITATIONS IN SCHOOL

Party invitations should only be given out during the school day when all of the same gender in a class, or the whole class are being invited.

Obviously parents may still arrange smaller parties outside of school hours by texting parents or delivering invites outside of school. Thank you for your understanding.

PACKED LUNCHES AT SCHOOL

We encourage healthy lunches in school. Packaged, sweet, processed foods should be kept to a minimum. For ideas of healthy options please see the DE Healthy Lunchbox leaflet on the school website.

HEALTHY BREAKS in SCHOOL

We encourage healthy breaks in school and do not allow children to bring in crisps, fizzy drinks or chocolate bars for break. If you decide not to book your child in for a school snack then please send in a healthy break e.g. bread, crackers and cheese, fruit or yoghurt. We want to encourage a healthy diet.

Welcome to a new term at Woods PS. We are delighted to have 23 P1 pupils join us and we hope that they will all settle quickly into school life. We are thankful for our dedicated staff team and want them to know how much we appreciate all that they do. We are fortunate to have such a capable staff team.

FLU IMMUNISATIONS P1-7

THE SCHOOL NURSE TEAM WILL BE IN SCHOOL ON MONDAY 7 NOVEMBER IN THE SCHOOL HALL TO ADMINISTER THE FLU IMMUNISATIONS P1-7. MORE DETAILS WILL BE SENT HOME WITH YOUR CHILD CLOSER TO THE TIME.

CORONAVIRUS (COVID-19): TESTING AND STAY AT HOME ADVICE IN RELATION TO CHILDREN

IF A CHILD OR YOUNG PERSON HAS A POSITIVE COVID-19 TEST RESULT, THEY SHOULD STAY AT HOME AND AVOID CONTACT WITH OTHER PEOPLE FOR THREE DAYS AFTER THE DAY THEY TOOK THE TEST OR FROM THE DAY THEIR SYMPTOMS STARTED (WHICHEVER WAS EARLIEST).

AFTER THREE DAYS, IF THEY FEEL WELL AND DO NOT HAVE A HIGH TEMPERATURE, THEY CAN RETURN TO SCHOOL AS THE RISK OF PASSING THE INFECTION ON TO OTHERS IS LOWER. THIS IS BECAUSE CHILDREN TEND TO BE INFECTIOUS TO OTHER PEOPLE FOR LESS TIME THAN ADULTS.

CHILDREN WHO USUALLY GO TO SCHOOL OR CHILDCARE AND WHO LIVE WITH SOMEONE WHO HAS A POSITIVE CORONAVIRUS TEST RESULT SHOULD CONTINUE TO ATTEND AS NORMAL.

EXCEPTIONAL CLOSURES POLICY (In the event of extreme weather)

An exceptional closure is unplanned, and is due to unforeseen circumstances such as adverse weather conditions, power failure, or situations which affect the safety of pupils and staff.

In times of extreme weather, such as a heavy snowfall, the Principal will consider and carryout a risk assessment based on the following issues:

- Transport Can buses, meal deliveries etc. reach the school, particularly if the unforeseen circumstances affect a large proportion of pupils?
- Can pupils and staff access the school building safely?
- Can pupils and staff be evacuated in an emergency?
- In an emergency, could the Emergency Services access the school?
- Is the area designated for disembarkation from transport safe for pupils?
- If a limited number of staff and pupils can attend, is the pupil teacher ratio acceptable?

The Principal will endeavour to make a decision at the earliest possible time. Decisions the night before can only be taken when all the indications are that adverse conditions will continue overnight.

Every effort will be made by the School to ensure that the grounds and building are safe for use.

Should continuing severe weather conditions throughout the school day impact further on the risk assessment then a decision to close early will be communicated to parents and staff at the earliest possible time.

We would appreciate every reasonable effort by staff to get to work. It is essential that staff and parents/carers keep in communication with the school as to their current position.

In the event of school closure, the following procedures will be followed:

- 1. A note placed on the School website front page.
- 2. A text to a parent's mobile phone number (please always ensure that the school is aware of any changes to your mobile phone or contact details).
- 3. If we decide to close early, a text or telephone call from the school.
- 4. If in doubt, please phone the school in the morning to check it is open before leaving your home.

It is always very important that parents make informed decisions on the safety of their children travelling on dangerous roads regardless of whether the school is open or closed. Please do what is safe for your own family on extreme weather days.

Parents should not post details of school closures on social media sites.

Inaccurate information can quickly circulate in the community.
